This 15-credit Graduate Certificate in Hospital and Health System Preparedness provides students with knowledge and skills to protect the critical infrastructure of hospitals and health systems. The curriculum uses a systems-based and an all-hazards approach to preparedness. Students conduct assessments and develop emergency operations plans.
