The Graduate Certificate in Technical Management is a program for students who aim to pursue a career as a Program Manager, Project Manager, Lead System Engineer, or Test Manager where skills will include responsibilities for overseeing and coordinating projects within organizations, planning, organizing, and executing a project from start to finish, designing, implementing, and coordinating technical design aspects of a system, or planning, testing, and evaluating activities and oversee testing activities and testing teams.

Courses taken in the certificate program may be applied toward a master's degree in Systems Engineering, subject to restrictions outlined in GCAC-309 Transfer Credit (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/gcac/gcac-300/gcac-309-transfer-credit/>). Certificate students who wish to have certificate courses applied towards a graduate degree must apply and be admitted to that degree program. Admission to the graduate degree program is a separate step and is not guaranteed.
