Admission Requirements

Applicants apply for admission to the program via the J. Jeffrey and Ann Marie Fox Graduate School application for admission (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/admissions/how-to-apply>). Requirements listed here are in addition to Graduate Council policies listed under GCAC-300 Admissions Policies (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/>).

Applicants apply for admission to the program via the Fox Graduate School application for admission. The following are required:

- Baccalaureate degree with a 3.0 minimum undergraduate GPA (or equivalent).
- Submission of a completed online Fox Graduate School Application for Admission, including a Statement of Purpose, and Resume.
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended.

The language of instruction at Penn State is English. English proficiency test scores (TOEFL/IELTS) may be required for international applicants. Core Application Packet

- Completed online Fox Graduate School application and payment of nonrefundable application fee.
- Statement of purpose: a 2–3-page essay articulating career and educational goals that demonstrates written communication skills.
- Vita or Résumé.
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended.
- Candidates may be asked to participate in a video interview as part of the admissions process.
