

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (INTERCOLLEGE)

Admission Requirements

Applicants apply for admission to the program via the J. Jeffrey and Ann Marie Fox Graduate School application for admission (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/admissions/how-to-apply>). Requirements listed here are in addition to Graduate Council policies listed under GCAC-300 Admissions Policies (<https://gradschool.psu.edu/graduate-education-policies/>).

Admission is granted only to candidates who demonstrate high promise of success for graduate work. Admissions decisions are based on a review of a complete admission portfolio, including an application, short essays, a current resume, official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended (<http://gradschool.psu.edu/prospective-students/how-to-apply/new-applicants/requirements-for-graduate-admission/>), and two letters of recommendation. Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) or Graduate Record Exam (GRE) scores will not be accepted.

No specific prior course of study is required to be admitted. Applicants come from a wide range of backgrounds. Students entering the program are required to have a working knowledge of the Microsoft Office suite.

The language of instruction at Penn State is English. English proficiency test scores (TOEFL/IELTS) may be required for international applicants.
