****Beginning in the fall 2025 semester, the three graduate programs currently offered in the School for Engineering Design and Innovation (which includes Engineering, Law, and Policy) will be merged under the Engineering Design and Innovation (EDI) graduate program, with M.Eng. and M.S. degree options.****

The EDI master's degree will include a required course from the four core areas within the EDI school: Engineering, Law, and Policy (ELP), Engineering Design (EDSGN), Engineering Leadership and Innovation Management (ELIM), and Entrepreneurship (ESHP). Students will then pursue 6 additional credits within one of the four focus areas. Students interested in Engineering, Law, and Policy (ELP) will be able to pursue the ELP focus area as part of the EDI program starting in the fall 2025 semester.
