Learning Outcomes

1. **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE:** Leadership and Management in Public Organizations: Students will identify and investigate stakeholder concerns and articulate stakeholder perspectives, recognize ethical requirements, and break down budgetary concepts in public organizations.

4. **APPLY/CREATE:** Develop Policy: Students will develop research design for accurate assessment of societal issues, policy impact and use that assessment to develop potential policy solutions.
5. **APPLY/CREATE:** Apply a Public Service Perspective to Data Driven Decision Making: Students will articulate and apply public service values including democracy, integrity, innovation, inclusion, and equity. They will be able to illustrate ethical conduct and be prepared to advance professionally in careers serving the public.
6. **COMMUNICATE:** Communicate Effectively in a Diverse Workforce and Citizenry: Students will collaborate with colleagues from diverse backgrounds, communicate within public organizations, and examine policy impacts comprehensively, considering a diverse population.
