

MASTER OF LAWS (LL.M.)

Admissions Requirements

The LL.M. program at Penn State Dickinson Law is highly selective with a limited number of highly qualified students admitted each year. To be considered for admission, applicants must have completed, or be in the process of completing, a first professional degree in law. This is generally a J.D. from a U.S. law school or the equivalent to the J.D. from a law school outside of the U.S. Successful applicants are often licensed to practice law and have professional experience in legal practice.
