

LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION, MINOR

Requirements for a minor may be completed at any campus location offering the specified courses for the minor. Students may not change from a campus that offers their major to a campus that does not offer their major for the purpose of completing a minor.

Program Description

The Livestock Production undergraduate minor prepares students for abundant employment opportunities in swine, beef, and sheep production and meat processing. Students will integrate science with applied production and marketing practices. Supporting course selection can be tailored to specific student interests in nutrition, welfare, animal health, sustainability, meat processing, or evaluation. Though such experience certainly isn't necessary, this minor is a logical extension for students with 4-H or FFA livestock experience.
