Certificate Learning Objectives

- **Apply social justice values:** Define and apply fundamental social justice values in personal and professional settings.
- **Articulate power differences:** Articulate how power differences structure life outcomes, particularly regarding the role of class and economic status, gender, sexuality, race, physical and mental ability, geography, environment, and other related categories.
- **Create and evaluate arguments:** Create and evaluate arguments on the role of social justice in furthering a more just and egalitarian democracy.
- **Evaluate and address injustices:** Demonstrate the critical thinking, reading, listening, and analytical skills necessary to evaluate and address injustices in one's community, one's workplace, and other areas of civic life.
- **Social justice principles:** Understand principles of justice as they relate to fields such as education, government, health, media, religion, business, art, technology, environmental science, and others.
- **Social justice scholarship:** Apply classic and contemporary social justice scholarship to compare and contrast scholarly understandings of "diversity," "justice," and related concepts, including how such ideas function in both academe and the greater world.
