Entrance to Major

In addition to the Carnegie unit and minimum GPA requirements¹ described by University policies, all students applying for entrance to any of the engineering majors at Behrend, Berks, or Capital College must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA by the end of the semester prior to applying for entrance to the major and have completed, with a minimum grade of C: CHEM 110, MATH 140, MATH 141, and PHYS 211. These courses must be completed by the end of the semester during which the entrance-to-major process is carried out.

¹ In the event that the major is under enrollment control, a higher minimum cumulative grade-point average is likely to be needed.
