Requirements for the Minor

A grade of C or better is required for all courses in the minor, as specified by Senate Policy 59-10 (<https://senate.psu.edu/students/policies-and-rules-for-undergraduate-students/59-00-minors-and-certificates/>). In addition, at least six credits of the minor must be unique from the prescribed courses required by a student's major(s).

Select 15 credits (at least 6 credits at the 400-level) in NUTR. No more than 3 credits of NUTR 495B and 3 credits of NUTR 294, NUTR 494 or NUTR 494H can count toward the additional courses credit requirement. Independent study credits (NUTR 296 and NUTR 496) do not count toward the Nutrition Studies minor. ¹		15
