Entrance to Major

Nutrition and Dietetics Option

In order to be eligible for entrance to the Nutrition and Dietetics option in the major, a student must:

1. attain at least a C (2.00) cumulative grade-point average for all courses taken at the University;
2. have third-semester classification (<https://www.registrar.psu.edu/enrollment/semester-classification.cfm>); and
3. attain a C or better in NUTR 251, BIOL 161, BIOL 162, BIOL 163, BIOL 164, and CHEM 110 or CHEM 130.

Health Sciences Option

In order to be eligible for entrance to the Health Sciences option in the major, a student must:

1. attain at least a C (2.00) cumulative grade-point average for all courses taken at the University
2. have third-semester classification (<https://www.registrar.psu.edu/enrollment/semester-classification.cfm>); and
3. attain a C or better in NUTR 251.
