Requirements for a minor may be completed at any campus location offering the specified courses for the minor. Students may not change from a campus that offers their major to a campus that does not offer their major for the purpose of completing a minor.

Program Description

South Asia is an important world region, home to a quarter of the world's population and dynamic modern cultures and economies. The region is comprised of India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Bhutan, Sri Lanka, the Maldives, and Afghanistan. South Asian Studies may include the study of the languages, societies, cultures, religions, literatures, histories, economies, politics and diasporas of the countries and peoples of South Asia. This is an 18-credit, interdisciplinary minor for students who want a foundational understanding of South Asia in its historical and contemporary forms.
