Degree Completion

Students accepted into the Business Analytics and Information Systems major are expected to enroll at University Park the start of their third-year or sooner if appropriate. In addition, Senate Policy 83-80.5 stipulates that the college dean and program faculty may require up to 24 credits of course work in the major to be taken in the college where the degree is earned. Based on this policy, the Smeal College of Business has set the following credit earning limitations for Business Analytics and Information Systems majors:

1. Eighteen credits of 300/400 level prescribed and additional courses in the major field must be completed with Management Information Systems faculty at University Park.
2. Six additional credits of 300/400 level related and supporting courses must also be completed at University Park. See the Business Analytics and Information Systems Suggested Academic Plan for details.
