## Degree Completion

Students accepted into the Real Estate (REST\_BS) major are expected to enroll at University Park the fall semester after gaining entrance to the major or sooner. In addition, Senate Policy 83-80.5 stipulates that the college dean and program faculty may require up to 24 credits of course work in the major to be taken in the college where the degree is earned. Based on this policy and the College's accreditation standards, the Smeal College of Business program faculty have set the following credit earning limitations for REST\_BS majors:

1. Eighteen credits of 300/400 level prescribed and additional courses in the major field must be completed with faculty in the Real Estate program.
2. Six additional credits of 300/400 level supporting courses must also be completed at University Park. See the Real Estate Suggested Academic Plan for details.
