Accreditation

Penn State recognizes the need for continuous program assessment. The JRCERT (Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology) provides programmatic accreditation and ensures the Radiological Sciences Program follows established standards. The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance and medical dosimetry. The Radiologic Sciences program at Schuylkill is fully accredited by the JRCERT. The Radiological Sciences program at Greater Allegheny will be applying for transfer of sponsorship for accreditation through the JRCERT.
